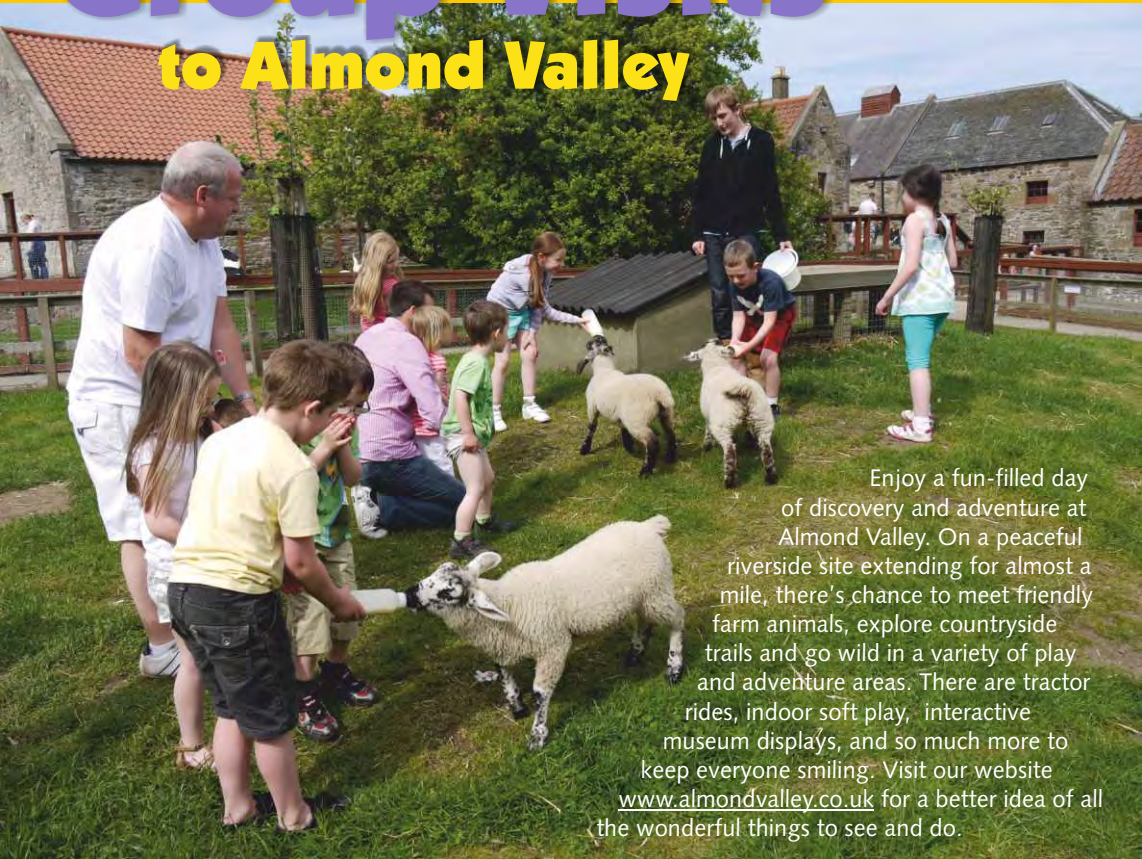


Group Visits to Almond Valley

Almond Valley welcomes group visits and offers ample facilities, including the opportunity to book covered accommodation for eating packed lunches. To qualify for group discount:

- your group must consist of at least 10 persons paying admission charge
- your visit must be pre-booked and confirmed at least a week in advance
- you enter the site as a single party under the charge of the group leader
- the group leader accepts responsibility for the good conduct of children in your group

Different discount and booking procedures apply to School Visits, which we define as groups of children aged between 3 and 17 visiting during school term time to undertake studies associated to the National Curriculum. If your visit meets these criteria please complete the Schools Visits booking form instead.

Admission costs only £5.50 for adults, £4.00 for children aged 3 -17. Group bookings qualify for a 10% discount on admission charges. Entry for the under 3's is free of charge.

What Happens Now?

First telephone us to ensure that we can accept your visit on your chosen date. Then complete your booking form, and post or fax this to us (01506 497771). We'll confirm your booking within a week of receipt and provide safety information, advice on risk assessment and a pledge of good conduct which the group leader should sign.

You should receive a detailed timetable of activities about a fortnight before your visit.

Conditions

- The adults in your party remain responsible for exercising normal parental control over the safety and conduct of children in their care; the nominated group leader is responsible for ensuring that this is understood. Dangerous or disruptive behaviour may result in the termination of your visit.
- Your group must enter as a single party; assembling outside the main entrance if required.
- Your timetable must be adhered to; late arrival may result in activities being changed or cancelled.
- The full cost of your visit must be paid on or before the date of your visit.
